

Nassif Aquatic Center (NAC) General Facility Rules:

1. Please follow all posted rules at special areas of the Aquatic Center.
2. Admission will be charged for all guests entering the facility ages 4 years and older.
3. Daily admission patrons who leave the facility must obtain a wristband from the front desk in order to return without having to pay for re-entry. Wristbands are good for that day only.
4. Children under the age of 10 must be supervised by a paying adult 15 years of age or older.
5. An adult may not supervise more than 8 children at any one time and must maintain visual contact at all times.
6. Admittance to the pool will be refused for: drunkenness, inability to care for self, perceived detriment to the decorum of the pool, improper attire, improper behavior, and/or infectious conditions or contagious disease such as colds, open sores, influenza, eye infections, rash or diarrhea.
7. Controlled substances, alcohol, weapons, outside food or drink, chewing gum, snorkels, inappropriate attire, coolers, glass containers, and dangerous or offensive acts are prohibited.
8. This is a tobacco free facility. Please smoke only in designated areas located outside of the facility.
9. Lost, stolen, or damaged articles are the responsibility of the owner. Lockers are available for patrons on a daily basis only. Patrons may bring their own lock or locks are available for purchase at the Front Desk. Personal locks left on lockers at the end of the day will be removed by staff.
10. Proper swim attire is required and a fitting t-shirt only may be worn in addition with proper swim attire. Swimming attire must meet the requirements of the WPR written swimwear standards. A copy of those standards may be reviewed by contacting WPR staff.
11. Only U.S Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices will be permitted in the pool. Please leave all rafts, rings, and water wings at home. The Nassif Aquatic Center will provide such life jackets however; they will be available only on a first-come first-serve basis and must remain within the facility. Personal Flotation Devices will not be allowed on the slides, diving boards, or in diving area.
12. Children who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper and appropriate swim attire. Swim diapers are available for purchase at the front desk. Please report any accidents to facility staff immediately.
13. School aged children (5 years and older) must use the locker room facility appropriate for their gender. There are two family changing rooms for your convenience.
14. If you need an accommodation to safely and enjoyably participate in any of our programs please see the pool manager.

Warrensburg Parks & Recreation (WPR) reserves the right to:

Close the pool for special aquatic programs, unfavorable weather, and/or low attendance

Change or modify the rules at any time deemed necessary

Refuse service to any patron deemed in the best interest of the facility

All ordinances of the City of Warrensburg shall be enforced
